## Duo *Élégie*—Lilly Vadaneaux and Einav Grushka

Lilly and Einav began playing together in 2015 at Junior Guildhall School of Music, where they studied piano with Stephen Coombs and Andrew Bottrill. As soloists, both Einav and Lilly won the Junior Guildhall Piano Prize in 2019 and 2020 respectively, and were both finalists in Guildhall's renowned Lutine Prize, in 2019 and 2021. Lilly and Einav have performed as a duo at St Martin-in-the-Fields in London, as well as at Guildhall and other venues, and their repertoire includes works by Debussy, De Falla, Ravel, Bach and Schubert. They are currently a Cambridge Instrumental Award Scheme ensemble, and receive coaching from pianist Andrew West. Lilly is a third-year music student and Choral Scholar at Clare College, and Einav is a

fourth-year Spanish and French student at Queens' College.
