He attended Ipswich School as a music scholar for Sixth Form, and for three years went to the Royal Academy of Music Junior Department, where he studied organ with Anne Marsden Thomas, conducting with Alexander Walker and continuo playing with Debbie Diamond.

From 2018-2019, he was Senior Organ Scholar at Wells Cathedral, where he accompanied the Cathedral Choir for daily Evensong, special services and premiers of new music; he also assisted in the

training of choristers.

As an accompanist and chamber musician, Harrison enjoys a varied schedule of playing with instrumentalists, singers and choirs, and has played in a variety of venues across the country and Europe. Outside of music, Harrison has a keen interest in a wide variety of literature, philosophy, and history.
